ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NUMBER 2018-20 RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2018, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2019 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 6, 2018, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$42,790.00 and;

WHEREAS, the 2018 valuation for assessment for the Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District, as certified by the County Assessor is \$17,122,780.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District during the 2018 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 2.499 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2018.

Section 2. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to either immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Custer County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District as hereinabove determined and set, or be authorized and directed to certify to the County Commissioners of Custer County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District as hereinabove determined and set based upon the final (December) certification of valuation from the County Assessor.
