ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT RESOLUTION NUMBER 2023-19

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TERMINATION OF THE MORATORIUM PROHIBITING THE SALE OF WATER AND WASTEWATER TAPS AS ESTABLISHED IN RESOLUTION 2021-12

WHEREAS. On January 1, 2022, The Round Mountain Water and Sanitation District (District) placed a moratorium prohibiting the sales of water and wastewater taps due to overloaded conditions of the existing wastewater treatment plant and the inability to procure an effective and affordable treatment upgrade, and

WHEREAS, although a replacement treatment system has not yet been procured, biological supplementation added to the existing plant has produced additional treatment capacity. The District is also developing a Pilot study on new innovative treatment technologies that are effective and affordable, and

WHEREAS, the District deems it appropriate to terminate the moratorium to provide growth within the towns of Westcliffe and Silver Cliff and provide the District with needed funds necessary to implement the wastewater treatment pilot study and provide a permanent treatment solution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROUND MOUNTAIN WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT, COLORADO THAT:

Effective January 1, 2024, the moratorium established in Resolution 2021-12 be terminated and, subject to the District's Rules, Regulations and Fee schedules, the sale of water and wastewater taps be made available to the public.
